

Château Berliquet, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru Classé 2014

Bordeaux, France



PRODUCER

Berliquet is one of the oldest vineyards in Saint-Emilion, covering 6.5 hectares. The arrival, in 2008, of Nicholas Thienpont and Stéphane Deroncourt marked the beginning of the search of even more precision in the vineyard with the aim to express the finesse of this terroir. Most recently, the property was bought by the Chanel group in 2017.

VINEYARDS

The vines lie very close to the village of Saint-Emilion, between those of Châteaux Angelus and Ausone. Partly they lie on the clay-chalk plateau, with limestone subsoil, partly on a west-facing limestone slope topped by colluvial deposits and windblown sands.

WINEMAKING

This aged for 14-16 months in small French oak barrels, of which 45% were new.

TASTING NOTES

this 2014 is a velvety, complex wine, having beautiful Saint-Emilion perfume with finesse. Mid ruby-garnet colour, aromas are layered and nuanced leading to a medium bodied, intensely flavoured, silkily textured palate. This wine has subtlety and grace, the finish being fresh and long.
