#### Macon-Prissé Vignerons des Terres Secretes 2022

This 2022 has a very pale lemon-green colour, aromas being lively and scented, recalling fresh peach and lemon. Palate is light and zippy, having pure, citrus flavours.

#### Château Beauregard Ducasse Graves 2019

From the highest hillside in the appellation, classic Graves aromas – cedar, spice and smokiness – combine seamlessly with ripe berry fruits. This is a super wine, with bright, intense fruit and a textured palate. There is lovely balance and a classy, long finish.

#### Paparuda Pinot Grigio Cramele Recas, Romania 2022

This is a perfumed, zippy Pinot Grigio, having a very pale lemon-gold colour. Aromas are pure and delicate, with notes of grapefruit and peach, the finish being clean, gentle and fresh.

#### Racine Picpoul de Pinet Bruno Lafon & François Chamboissier 2022

Here is a vivacious Languedoc white with zesty fruitiness and lively acidity. Pale lemon-green colour, aromas are intense, recalling lime and pear, with an attractive scent of a fresh sea breeze. Palate is light and lifted, with a beautiful creamy texture, rich middle, and a clean, saline finish.

#### Château Les Reuilles Bordeaux Rouge 2020

Les Reuilles is regularly one of our favourite, readyto-drink red Bordeaux. Located in the Entre-Deux-Mers, the Todesco family's Merlot (60%) / Cabernet Sauvignon (40%) blend is a full bodied, juicy Claret, having concentrated, subtly spiced, black berry flavours, supple texture, and a classy finish.

#### Malbec Las Pampas Mendoza 2022

This Argentinean red has a pleasing, fruity nose and a charming supple character. Grown on the foothills of the Andes, there is plenty of freshness (thanks in part to the high slopes of the vineyards) and appetising black cherry flavours.

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#### Château Les Marcieux Haut-Médoc 2018

A brilliant ruby colour in the glass, with wonderfully attractive aromas, this 55%/45% Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot blend has the utmost purity. There is good middle fruit, supple texture and a harmonious finish.

#### Château La Croix Blanche Francs Côtes de Bordeaux 2019

85% Merlot with 15% Cabernet Franc, this has a lifted, aromatic quality on the nose, with notes of ripe redcurrant and raspberry. Full bodied and juicy, tannins are fine grained, the finish being balanced and refreshing.

#### Château Begadan Médoc 2018

Old vines and sound, sustainable vineyard management account for the beautiful fruit intensity and natural elegance of this wine. Complex aromas of ripe red berries, warm brick and spice lead onto a rich, medium bodied wine of great character. This is a charming wine that will give immediate pleasure.

#### Château Faure-Beauséjour Fronsac 2019

With its elegantly scented, spicy aroma, this Fronsac is classically made and finely textured, being a blend of 85% Merlot with 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc. The fruit is sweet and there is ample flesh, finishing with perfect tone and balance.



## The French Fine Wine Twelve

This case contains 3 each of: Sancerre Terre de Maimbray, Pascal et Nicolas Reverdy 2022 Mâcon-Uchizy, Domaine de l'Arfentière 2022 Château Belle Coline, Blaye Côtes de Bordeaux 2015 Les Traboules, Coteaux du Lyonnais, Clusel-Roch 2020

#### Sancerre Terre de Maimbray Pascal et Nicolas Reverdy 2022

Pascal Reverdy produces an ultra-precise, concentrated Sancerre. Aromas are intense and scented, with notes of cut lime and elderflower. The palate is light bodied and lively, having richness of fruit, chalky minerality and an attractive, silky texture.

#### Mâcon-Uchizy Domaine de l'Arfentière 2022

Raphael Sallet of Domaine de l'Arfentière has made a great success of his 2022 Mâcon-Uchizy. Pale lemongreen colour, classic, lemony aromas lead to a light, lifted, unoaked palate. The finish has harmonious freshness.

#### Château Belle Coline Blaye Côtes de Bordeaux 2015

From the excellent 2015 Right Bank vintage, aromas are inviting, bringing together spiced, red berry fruitiness with savoury, meaty tones. This is a medium weight Claret, being gently textured, and having good length.

#### Les Traboules Coteaux du Lyonnais, Clusel-Roch 2020

The Clusel-Roch family is most famously celebrated for their Syrah from the slopes of Côte-Rôtie. More recent vineyard purchases have extended into the nearby Coteaux du Lyonnais, where it is the Gamay grape that thrives. This is a crunchy, organically made red, having light body, scented, red summer fruit flavours, and a radiant finish.

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#### Chablis Domaine Daniel Dampt 2022

Dampt's Village Chablis comes predominantly from old, 45 year-old vines that grow near the family Domaine, in the hamlet of Milly. This 2022 has pristine, intense, lemony aromas. This is a lively, freshly citrusy mouthful, being silkily textured and finely structured. It finishes with raciness, vitality and excellent length.

#### Château Laujac Médoc 2016

This 2016 has beautifully fine aromas, combining smoky spice with violets and cassis. The Merlot in the blend (51%) brings rich fleshiness and roundness, with Cabernet Sauvignon (42%) and Petit Verdot (7%) contributing energy, structure and scent. The finish is precise and persistent.



## Champagne Pierre Vaudon Grand Cru 2016

2016 is a stunning vintage for Pierre Vaudon. As is the norm here, Pinot Noir comprises 75% of the blend, providing generous middle-palate richness. 25% Chardonnay contributes finesse, lemony freshness and delicacy of texture – all grapes having come from prime Grand Cru vineyards. The wine aged for 5 years in the cellars in Avize, prior to disgorgement in summer 2022.

Pale gold in the glass, with vivacious bubbles, aromas are incredibly attractive and youthful, recalling apricot patisserie, honeyed peach, red fruits, with a hint of toasted brioche. Full bodied and having a very fine, straight structure, texture is silky-smooth the finish being harmonious, mineral and long-flavoured (for drinking 2023-2030+).

#### Champagne Pierre Vaudon Premier Cru NV

£91.85

The ultimate celebratory champagne, our Non-Vintage Pierre Vaudon is vivacious and silky-smooth. Pinot Noir from Grand Cru vineyards makes up 75% of the blend, bringing structure and depth of flavour. The remaining 25% is Chardonnay sourced from Premier Cru sites on the Côte des Blancs, contributing finesse and racy lemony character. Matured in bottle for 36 months, this cannot fail to satisfy the taste-buds. Superb for immediate drinking, it also matures superbly in a cool cellar, gaining complexity, for five years or more.

# A Dente

Champagne Louis Roederer Collection NV

Roederer's multi-vintage Collection cuvée is a blend of 40% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier sourced exclusively from three of the Domaine's own vineyards: La Rivière, La Montagne and La Côte.

Pale golden colour with beautifully vivacious bubbles, aromas are very fresh and taut, recalling red fruits, brioche and pain grillé. Palate is full, supple and generous, having exquisite freshness, fine structure and very lively mouthfeel. This champagne is marked by its elegance and finesse, having lovely depth of flavour. The finish is persistent, crisp and silky.

#### Chablis Domaine Daniel Dampt 2022



Dampt's Village Chablis comes predominantly from old, 45 year-old vines that grow near the family Domaine, in the hamlet of Milly. No oak is used here, so this is a pristine expression of Chardonnay grown on these chalky hillsides. Colour is bright, pale lemon-gold, having pure, lemony aromas. This is a lively, intense, freshly citrusy mouthful, being silkily textured and finely structured. It finishes with raciness, vitality and excellent length.

# Côtes du Ogier`s (

### Le Temps Est Venu

Côtes du Rhône, Domaine Ogier 2021 £49.95

Ogier's Côtes du Rhône comes two family-owned vineyards: one in Plan de Dieu, which gives more powerful, richer styles; complementing this, freshness and structure is contributed by grapes grown at higher altitude in the Visan commune. A blend of 96% Grenache with 4% Syrah, this 2021 is bright, ruby in colour, aromas being fragrant and pure, recalling ripe strawberry, bramble fruits, with pleasing hints of garrigue herbs. The palate is full bodied, having excellent concentration, juicy, supple texture and a perfectly balanced, smooth finish.

#### Château Beauregard Ducasse Graves 2019

From the highest hillside in the appellation, classic Graves aromas – cedar, spice and smokiness – combine seamlessly with ripe berry fruits. This is a super wine, with bright, intense fruit and a textured palate. There is lovely balance and a classy, long finish.

#### Château de Bel-Air Lalande de Pomerol 2016

#### £76.10 \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ ch stream,

leads gently southward towards the Barbanne stream, with the Pomerol appellation just across the water. This is one of the best terroirs of Lalande-de-Pomerol, with gravel soils making up 70% of the estate, the balance being gravels mixed with iron-rich clay. A blend of 73% Merlot, 19% Cabernet Franc with 8% Cabernet Sauvignon, which aged in 40% new barrels, this 2016 is truly blossoming. Colour is deep ruby, the nose being vibrant with floral red fruits. Palate shows fine balance between rich fruit density, gentle tannins, refreshing acidity and smooth, long aftertaste – a lovely, complete wine (for drinking 2023-2028+).

#### Château Cantemerle 5ème Cru Classé Haut-Médoc 2012 Château Cantemerle was hugely on song

Château Cantemerle was hugely on song in 2012 and we are delighted to be offering it, now it has reached maturity. One is immediately entranced by the aromas that are intense, floral, ripe and complex. This is a wine of tremendous fruit purity and elegance. Concentrated red fruits and silky, creamy textures abound. It has a fine structure and excellent freshness, with a long finish.

#### Château Grand-Puy-Lacoste 5ème Cru Classé Pauillac 2014

£200.20

This beautiful wine was made by one of the most adept, classic wine makers in Bordeaux, owner François-Xavier Borie, assisted by his daughter Emeline. In 2014, Cabernet Sauvignon makes up 82% of the blend, Merlot 18%, with the Grand Vin representing only 45% of the estate's production. Colour is solid, deep ruby-garnet, the nose being fragrant, rich and complex, with notes of ripe black fruits and spices. The palate is powerfully built, with bouncy, fresh fruit personality, great concentration, and elegant tannins of exceptional finesse. The finish is harmonious and very long (for drinking 2023–2035+).
