IGP Pays d'Oc, Domaine Gayda 2021

Domaine Gayda's Flying Solo rosé celebrates the intrepid Aéropostale pilots, who ensured the smooth running of postal deliveries in France in the 1920s. A 50/50 blend of Grenache and Cinsault, this is the ultimate easy-drinking, refreshing rosé, with a lovely, pale colour. Palate is light and juicy, recalling fresh red berries. The finish is clean and bright (12.5%).

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IGP Pays d'Oc, Domaine Gayda 2021

LA MINUFTTF ROSÉ

This organic rosé is named after the Minuette rose Domaine Gayda's owner, Tim Ford, cultivated in Kenya during his 25 years of rose production. Both have a very pale colour and delicately floral bouquet, this being a blend of 60% Mourvèdre, 15% Syrah, 15% Grenache, 10% Cinsault, grown on the limestone terroir of La Livinière. Light in body, the palate has intensity and delicacy, the finish being lifted and pure (12.5% - organic certified).

100% Cabernet Franc, this organic Chinon Rosé has a very pale colour, aromas being delightfully vibrant and red berry-scented. Light, lively and lithe, there is satisfying crunchiness of fruit, lovely concentration and a dry, supple finish (12.5% - organic certified).



ROMANIN ROSÉ

Château Romanin, IGP Alpilles 2021

Château Romanin lies on the rocky, limestone slopes of the Alpilles hills, just south of Saint-Rémy-de-Provence. The original Templar château dates back to the 13th century, which, combined with the craggy hilltops, provides the most impressive backdrop for the property's 58 hectares of vineyards. Biodynamics have been practiced here since 1988, the Domaine being both biodynamic and organic certified. This is a beautiful pink, aromas being aromatic and fine: fresh cherry, redcurrant with a delicate floral tone. Palate is light and clean, having the most beautiful texture and freshly concentrated flavours. The finish is elegant and salivating (13% - organic certified).

This zesty Muscadet has wonderful richness and vibrancy. Very pale lemon-gold colour, aromas are open and attractive, with notes of fresh lime. Palate is racy and light bodied, with zippy fruit and a saline finish (12.5%).

Christophe Réthoré's 42 hectares of vines lie on the rolling hills of the Pays des Mauges, located between Muscadet to the west and Anjou to the east. This 2021 Les Parcelles is pale, lemon-green, aromas being discreet, recalling white peach and lemon. Light in body, this is an airy, up-lifting, unoaked Chardonnay style, the finish being thirst-quenching (12.5%).

IGP Pays d'Oc, Domaine Gayda 2021

Domaine Gayda's location high in the hills on the western edge of the Languedoc gives a style of Viognier that is fresher in style than one might expect from this sun-drenched sector of southern France. We discovered this wine 12 vintages ago, this 2021 being a particularly vibrant rendition. Pale lemon-gold, this has tight, scented aromas of floral, fresh apricots. Palate is light, perfumed and intense, the finish being beautifully balanced and bright (13%).



IGP Pays d'Oc, Domaine Gayda 2021

CHARDONNAY

This is the first vintage that we have shipped Domaine Gayda's Chardonnay, this 2021 being a fresh, cool-climate style, with roundness of body and creaminess of texture brought by the 25% of the blend that was fermented and matured for 6 months in French oak barrels. Aromas recall fresh lemon with perfumed stone fruits. Palate is juicy, the finish clean and fresh (13.5%).

Casa Vinicola Roxan 2020

From Abruzzo, on central Italy's Adriatic coast, this 100% Pecorino is a characterful, dry, full-flavoured white wine. Aromas recall grapefruit and white flowers, the palate being precise, with good richness and a refreshing, harmonious finish (12.5%).

Organically grown Chenin Blanc vines produce this brisk, dry Loire white. The colour is very pale gold, aromas recalling apples with lemon patisserie. This is a light, taut, focussed style, having mouthwatering acidity, tight concentration and a crisp, mineral finish (12.5% - organic certified).



PINOT BIANCO *Kellerei Kurtatsch, Alto Adige 2020* 12b 156.00 13.00

This is the fifth vintage we have shipped this brilliant Pinot Bianco from the slopes of the Alto Adige. It exudes mountain freshness and purity. Aromas are lively: fresh pear and lemon. The palate is medium bodied having a fine, silky texture, finishing fresh (13.5%).

The vineyards for our Macon-Prissé contain a high content of calcareous clay, contributing to the depth and supple texture of this wine. This 2020 has a very pale lemon-green colour, aromas being attractive and fine, recalling fresh peach and lemon. Palate is light bodied, with intense citrus flavours. There is lovely brightness of linear acidity to balance the wine's natural richness, the finish being harmonious (13%).

Domaine Jacques Rouzé 2021

2021 is a particularly energetic, crisp vintage for Jacques Rouzé's Quincy. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes come from the pebbly Villalin vineyard, on the right bank of the River Cher. With a very pale colour, aromas are vividly fruity, with notes of lime and gooseberry. On the palate, there is piercing Sauvignon freshness, body being light, texture silky. The finish is racy and bright (13%).

This crisp, dry Austrian Riesling has a wonderful, lifted perfume of green apples, freshly cut limes and honeysuckle. Light bodied yet intensely flavoured, this has a beautiful texture that coats and refreshes the palate. It is precise and taut, the finish being invigorating and steely (12.5%).

Dampt's Village Chablis comes predominantly from old, 40-45 year-old vines that grow near the family Domaine, in the hamlet of Milly. No oak is used here, allowing the individual character of the Chardonnay grape, grown on the chalky hillsides, to be crystalclear. Colour is bright, pale lemon-green with very fresh lemony aromas. This is a lively, well concentrated wine with an exhilarating finish (12%).



POUILLY-FUMÉ

Domaine Serge Dagueneau et Filles 2020

This Domaine is situated in the commune of Les Berthiers, combining complex soils of chalky, kimmeridgian marl (containing millions of tiny oyster shells) and flints. This 2020 has a pale lemon colour, the nose being intensely woven and fragrant, with notes of elderflower and gooseberry. Palate is full bodied and broad; flavours are rich, texture is luscious, the finish vivacious and persistent (14%).

Domaine Dominique Cornin 2020

Les Bruyères is a north-facing slope of blue schist that gives fine-boned, remarkably fresh Chardonnay. Here, colour is a very pale lemon-gold, aromas being gorgeously pure: nectarine and fresh lemon. Tightly wound on the palate, this has full body, fine texture and a rounded, harmonious aftertaste (13% - organic certified).



SAVENNIÈRES CLOS DU PETIT BEAUPREAU

Domaine des Deux Vallées 2020

Chenin Blanc from Savennières too often falls under the radar. This wine from Domaine des Deux Vallées is a reason to discover it, such is its quality, finesse an elegance. The vines lie in the Clos du Petit Beaupréau, where sandy loam topsoil leads to a schist base rock. Very pale gold colour, the nose has intense aromas of spiced apple tart and honeysuckle. Palate is full bodied, powerfully concentrated and intricately structured. With a beautiful, suave texture, the finish is vibrant and piercingly fresh (14% - for drinking 2022-2025+).



CHÂTEAU LAFONT-MENAUT BLANC

Lafont-Menaut was acquired by the Perrin family, which owns and runs the highlyacclaimed Château Carbonnieux, 6 years ago. 100% Sauvignon Blanc, this 2019 was barrel-aged for 9 months (25% new oak), the result being a white Bordeaux that boasts bright, primary citrus fruit aromatics and complex, flinty tones. Pale lemon-green colour, this is a full, finely textured wine, having lovely fruit intensity and a refreshing, mineral finish (13% - for drinking 2022-2024+).

VIRÉ-CLESSÉ QUINTAINE Domaine Guillemot-Michel 2019

The Guillemot-Michels, Marc and Pierrette, with daughter Sophie and son-in-law Gautier, farm their vineyards according to biodynamic principles. 2019 was a vintage of small volumes, due to spring frost and a dry summer, but the tiny Chardonnay grapes were tightly concentrated in flavour and acidity. Colour is a bright, aromas being incredibly pure, combining fresh nectarine and orange blossom. The palate is full bodied and layered, having energy and intensity, with a beguiling, silky texture (13.5% - organic certified).

POUILLY-FUMÉ LA BELLE ENDORMIE

Domaine Agisson 2020

2020 is the inaugural vintage of Jean-Philippe Agisson's Pouilly-Fumé, from a 0.5-hectare plot of organically cultivated vines in Tracy Sur Loire. Given Jean-Philippe's wealth of experience making Sauvignon Blanc from Pouilly at Domaine Didier Dagueneau (where he is Head Winemaker), it is no surprise that this wine is a beauty. He has named it `La Belle Endormie` - Sleeping Beauty - as he believes that Pouilly can fall into the shadow of its often more celebrated neighbour, Sancerre. Pale lemon-green, aromas are alluring, being floral, spicy and gooseberry scented. Palate is medium bodied, with complex, perfumed fruitiness, a fine, elegant texture, and a finish that is thirst-quenching (13% - for drinking 2022-2024+).

PERNAND-VERGELESSES BLANC

Luc and Lise Pavelot's Pernand Blanc comes from several hillside plots around the village, principally Belles Filles and La Morand, with some from Les Quartiers and Sur Herbeux. The wine was entirely vinified and aged in oak barrels, of which 25% were new. Green-golden in colour, this has freshly open, ripe aromas of real beauty. It is medium-bodied with zip and drive, showing intense fruit on the aftertaste (13% - organic certified - for drinking 2022-2025+).

Château de Bousval, Jardins de Wallonie 2019

For lovers of fresh Chardonnay from Burgundy, we invite you to discover this enchanting wine from Belgium's Jardins de Wallonie. Bright in colour, its aromas are finely woven: perfumed apricots, lemons and acacia flowers. Palate is full and racy, with generous fruit flavours and a silky-smooth texture. This has grace and poise, the finish being crystalline (12% - for drinking 2022-2023+).

KUMEU RIVER MATÉ`S VINEYARD CHARDONNAY6b 270.0045.00Kumeu 2018



The Brajokovich family of Kumeu River makes super-precise Chardonnays, which are amongst some of New Zealand's finest. Planted in 1990, the Maté's vineyard is the most splendid of all the Kumeu River bottles. It is planted with the Mendoza Chardonnay clone, which naturally gives wines that are generous in both body and flavour. In 2018, colour is bright lemon-green, with an expressive, smoky, floral, peach and lemon aroma. Palate has ample concentration and mouthcoating textures. It finishes with freshness (13% - for drinking 2022-2027+).

BEAUNE BLANC 1ER CRU BLANC CLOS DES MOUCHES6b 366.0061.00Domaine Seguin-Manuel 2020



Clos des Mouches has a firm reputation as one of Beaune's best vineyards, earning itself a place alongside the region's most famous whites. Thibault Marion of Seguin-Manuel makes an outstanding example in 2020, the wine's colour being pale, lemon-gold, aromas being abundantly ripe and bright. The palate is plump and powerful, with racy fruit character, and a spritely, long finish (13% - organic certified – for drinking 2022-2028+).

Exceptional Wines from the Loire Valley's Jacky Blot

The highly-respected father and son team of Jacky and Jean-Philippe Blot owns and runs Domaine de la Taille aux Loups in Montlouis and Domaine de la Butte in Bourgueil. We have long-admired their wines, which are some of the Loire Valley's most sensitively made, quality-driven examples. As we are familiar with in Burgundy, their vineyards are subdivided into small parcels, with each cuvée being a transparent expression of the specific site, vintage and grape variety (Chenin Blanc for Montlouis, Cabernet Franc for Bourgueil). For the first time, we are thrilled to introduce a Bourgueil to our selection.

MONTLOUIS SEC CLOS MICHET Domaine de la Taille aux Loups 2020

The Clos Michet is a well-exposed, south facing vineyard, where the 40-60 year old vines grow in sandy-clay soil over pure limestone. The wine was fermented and aged in French barrels, 20% of which were new. Colour is glistening gold, aromas being tightly-woven, recalling baked apple and fresh pear, with gentle hints of spiced hazelnuts bringing complexity. Full and vibrant on the palate, the texture is satiny, having breath-taking freshness to finish (13.5% - for drinking 2022-2027+).

From a silex-soiled, 6 hectare plot within the 12 hectare, walled Clos du Mosny, this cuvée is made from the second harvesting sweep of the vineyard -"at harvest-time we have 120 pickers, to ensure that grapes are brought in exactly at the right moment, when there is perfect balance between ripeness and acidity", says Jean-Philippe Blot. This 2020 is pale gold, having multi-layered aromas of apple blossom, almond pastry and spice. The palate is mouth-filling, rounded and supple. There is tremendous depth of flavour, refined structure and a long, mineral finish (13.5% - for drinking 2022-2030+).

BOURGUEIL LE HAUT DE LA BUTTE

Domaine de la Butte 2020

The 16-hectare Domaine de la Butte was acquired by Jacky Blot in 2002. Applying an approach seen on the Burgundian hillsides, he has separated the south-facing vineyard into different plots by geological strata as they go up the hill. From Cabernet Franc grapes harvested from the top sector of the slope, this 2020 Bourgueil is very deep ruby-purple in colour, aromas being intense: floral cassis and liquorice. Palate has great depth of dark berry fruit with a lifted herbal tone, tannins being superfine and silky. This is a wine of real personality, impeccably combining richness and intensity with Cabernet Franc's natural, vibrant freshness (13.5% - for drinking 2022-2030+).

Feteasca Neagra is one of eastern Europe`s most popular red grapes, this example from Romania being a crunchy, bright expression. Bright purple in colour, with attractive, slightly peppery, black cherry aromas, the palate is ripe and supple, with a clean, lively finish (13.5%).



UVAS DEL SOL MALBEC Mendoza, Familia Zuccardi 2021

Following in the footsteps of his father and grandfather, Sebastián Zuccardi creates wines of great purity, firmly rooted in the terroirs of Mendoza. Uvas del Sol Malbec has bright, black berry fruitiness and lovely, rounded texture. The finish is supple and juicy (13.5%).



CHÂTEAU CROIX BLANCHE Francs Côtes de Bordeaux 2019 12b 125.40 10.45

This organic certified, 7-hectare estate lies on Bordeaux's Right Bank in Francs Côtes de Bordeaux, just north-east of Saint-Emilion. 85% Merlot with 15% Cabernet Franc, this has a lifted, aromatic quality on the nose, with notes of ripe redcurrant and raspberry. Full bodied, tannins are fine grained, the finish being balanced and refreshing (13.5% - organic certified).

BEAUJOLAIS VIEILLES VIGNES Domaine Boulon 2020

The old vines for Domaine Boulon's Beaujolais are between 60 to 100 years in age, giving low yields of richly concentrated juice. This 2020 is mid ruby-purple colour, having ripe, freshly picked red cherry aromas. This is a light bodied, vibrant, joyful mouthful, with generous middle fruit and the perfect amount of freshness to finish (13%).

Ranuccio Neri's 2019 Chianti Colli Senesi is at once fruity, supple and refreshing - a great example of vibrant Sangiovese. Bright ruby in the glass, aromas are open and fragrant. Palate is medium bodied and generously flavoured, with notes of fresh red cherries and warming spices. This is a rounded wine, with a balanced, freshly tannic finish (13%).

Here is a lovely Médoc from vines located on deep Garonne gravels in the commune of Valeyrac. The much-admired Médoc expert, Eric Boissenot, is the oenologist here which may explain the excellent quality. 61% Merlot, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon with 2% Cabernet Franc, colour is mid ruby, aromas being scented with red fruits. Medium bodied, the palate has seductive silkiness, tannins being well-integrated, the finish having finesse (13%).



LE MAS

2020 is a great success for Pierre Clavel's "Le Mas." A blend of Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre, colour is mid ruby, aromas being having notes of black cherry and blackberry. The palate has richness and brightness in equal measure. Full bodied, there is good depth of flavour, suave texture, the finish being satisfying (14% - organic certified).

SAUMUR-CHAMPIGNY Domaine des Sanzay 2020

Domaine Clavel, Languedoc 2020

Set in the village of Varrains, Didier and Céline Sanzay's 28-hectare estate dates back to 1880. Didier represents the 5th generation here, with son Ludovic now at his side. The vines for this Saumur-Champigny lie on 'tuf' limestone soils, giving a style of Cabernet Franc that is plush, finely textured and has vivid fruitiness. Bright ruby in the glass, aromas are classic for the variety: cassis and fresh red berries. Palate is full, having a lovely core of fruitiness, the finish being harmonious and lively (14% - organic certified).



MOULIN-À-VENT Domaine de Forétal 2020

Domaine de Forétal is located in the hillside village of Vauxrenard. Jean-Yves Perraud is at the helm, making pure styles of Gamay from family-owned vineyards. Glistening rubypurple, the aromas of this Moulin-à-Vent recall crunchy black cherries and fragrant violets, leading to a palate that is full bodied with good intensity. This is an extremely well-made, finely structured example of Moulin-à-Vent, with a clean, fresh finish (13.5%).

This succulent 2019 Pic Saint Loup is a blend of 60% Syrah with 20% Grenache, 10% Mourvèdre and 10% Carignan. Lustrous deep purple-ruby colour, aromas recall black cherries, raspberries and spiced orange peel. Palate is full-bodied, having excellent depth of flavour, good structure and super-fine texture (14.5%).

From vineyards located in the village of Montelupo Albese, just east of Serralunga d'Alba, this is a charming, lively Dolcetto style. Mid ruby-purple, the nose has notes of blackberries and cherry blossom. Palate is medium bodied and rounded, with good concentration of pure fruit flavours and fresh length (13.5%).



COTEAUX DU LYONNAIS TRABOULES Clusel-Roch 2020

The Clusel-Roch family is most famously celebrated for their Syrah from the vertiginous slopes of Côte-Rôtie. More recent vineyard purchases have extended into the nearby Coteaux du Lyonnais, where it is the Gamay grape that thrives. The vines lie in the village of Millery, in the southern sector of the appellation, on gentle, south-east facing slopes. Bright ruby-purple colour, this is a crunchy, unoaked wine, having light body, beautiful scented, red summer fruit flavours, and a radiant finish (12.5% - organic certified).



SCHIAVA SONNTALER

Kellerei Kurtatsch, Alto Adige 2020

As is typical of the Schiava grape, this is a very pretty, glisteningly pale red wine, which could be mistaken for a deeply coloured rosé.
